Not yet, but the riff is: [Dm] (one-and, two-and, three) [Asus7] (and four-and)

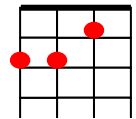
Chorus:

I'm [Dm] bound to [Am] go a- [Dm] way

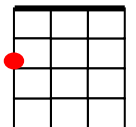
First verse: chap (Hamish)

[Dm] Wish I was in [Am] Shady Grove
[Dm] Sitting in a rocking chair
And [F] if the blues did [C] bother me
I'd [Dm] rock right [Am] out of [Dm] there {chorus - all}

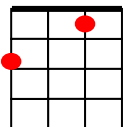

Second verse: girl (Sue)

[Dm] Wish that [Am] girl were [Dm] mine {chorus - all}

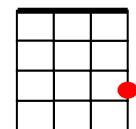

Third verse: chap (Martin)

[Dm] Take along a [Am] diamond [Dm] ring {chorus - all}

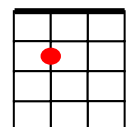

Fourth verse: girl (Suze)

[Dm] When you try to [Am] catch a fish

[Dm] Never [Am] look be- [Dm] hind {chorus - all}

Fifth verse: chap (Mike)

[Dm] When I was a [Am] little, little boy
All I [Dm] wanted was a Bowie knife
[F] Now that I'm a [C] full-grown man
I'm [Dm] looking [Am] for a [Dm] wife {chorus - all}

Outro: repeat chorus (no ukes) stop; then fade in riff – wait for Hamish to start – fade in singing “Shady Grove, my little love” and fade out again
