

We Can Work It Out – The Beatles

Lennon/McCartney 1965

[G] Try to see it [Gsus2] my [G] way
Do I have to [Gsus2] keep on talking [F] 'til I can't go [G] on?
While you see it [Gsus2] your [G] way
Run the risk of [Gsus2] knowing that our [F] love may soon be [G] gone
[C] We can work it [G] out
[C] We can work it [Dsus4] out[D]

[G] Think of what you're [Gsus2] say[G] ing
You can get it [Gsus2] wrong and still you [F] think that it's [G] alright
Think of what I'm [Gsus2] say[G] ing
We can work it [Gsus2] out and get it [F] straight, or say good [G] night
[C] We can work it [G] out
[C] We can work it [Dsus4] out[D]

Bridge: (2nd and 4th lines in ¾ time)


[Em] Life is very short, and there's no [C] time [B]
For fussing and [Em/E] fight [Em/D] ing, my [Em/C] friend[Em/B]
[Em] I have always thought that it's a [C] crime [B]
So, I will [Em] ask you [Em/E] once [Em/D] again [Em/B]

[G] Try to see it [Gsus2] my [G] way
Only time will [Gsus2] tell if I am [F] right or I am [G] wrong
While you see it [Gsus2] your [G] way
There's a chance that [Gsus2] we might fall [F] apart before too [G] long
[C] We can work it [G] out
[C] We can work it [Dsus4] out[D]

Repeat Bridge:

[G] Try to see it [Gsus2] my [G] way
Only time will [Gsus2] tell if I am [F] right or I am [G] wrong
While you see it [Gsus2] your [G] way
There's a chance that [Gsus2] we might fall [F] apart before too [G] long
[C] We can work it [G] out
[C] We can work it [Dsus4] out[D]
