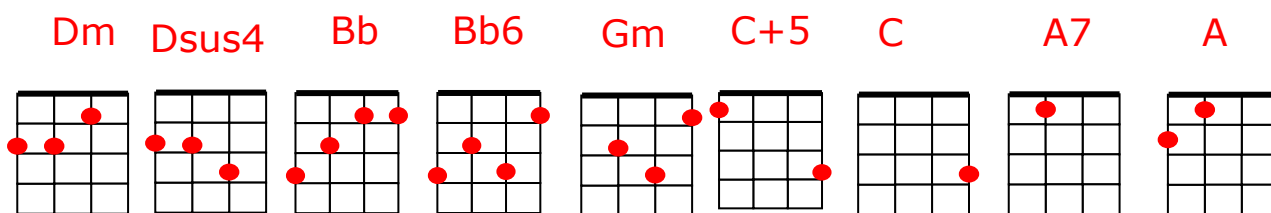


Cold as Ice Foreigner (written by Lou Gramm & Mick Jones) and simplified by BURP, e.g. excluding the guitar solo and a revised outro



Intro: [Dm*] x lots

[Dm*] You're as cold as ice
 [Bb*] You're willing to sacrifice our [Dm*] love [Bb*]
 [Dm*] You never take advice
 [Bb*] Someday you'll pay the price, I [Gm] know
 I've [F] seen it before, it happens [C+5] all the time
 You're [Dm] closing the door, you leave the [Bb] world be- [C] hind
 You're [F] digging for gold, you're [C+5] throwing away
 A [Gm] fortune in feelings, but [A7] someday you'll pay

In-betweenintro: [Dm*] [Bb*]

[Dm*] You're as cold as ice
 [Bb*] You're willing to sacrifice our [Dm*] love [Bb*]
 [Dm*] You want paradise
 [Bb*] But someday you'll pay the price, I [Gm] know
 I've [F] seen it before, it happens [C+5] all the time
 You're [Dm] closing the door, you leave the [Bb] world be- [C] hind
 You're [F] digging for gold, you're [C+5] throwing away
 A [Gm] fortune in feelings, but [A7] someday you'll pay [A7]

[Dm] (Cold [A] as [A7] ice) You know that you are
 [Dm] (Cold [A] as [A7] ice) As cold as ice to me
 [Dm] (Cold [A] as [A7] ice) [A7]

Outro:

[Dm*] You're as cold as ice
 [Bb*] You're willing to sacrifice our [Dm*] love; cold as ice
 [Bb*] Someday you'll pay the price
 [Dm*] Cold as ice [Bb*] Cold as ice
 [Dm*] Cold as ice [Bb*] Cold as ice [Dm*]

Notes:

[Dm*] is two beats of Dmsus4 followed by two beats of Dm. Twice.
 [Bb*] is two beats of Bb6 followed by two beats of Bb. Twice.
 If that's a bit tricky, just stick with Dm and Bb throughout.
