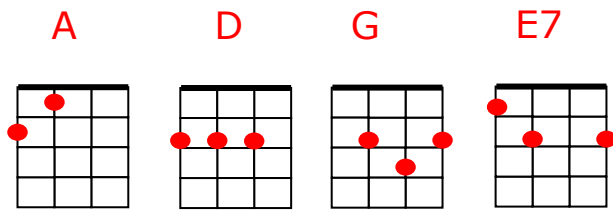


Highway to Hell inspired by the UOGB's take on the classic AC/DC song

 [A] Don't need reason; [D] [G] don't need rhyme

 [A] Going down; [D] [G] party time
